

NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 6 of AMWSLAI-COMELEC RESOLUTION 2022-001 the following are the grounds for disqualification of a voter pursuant to Rule 5, (Who may Vote in the Election), Section 2 of Board Resolution 2022-138:

- 7.3.1 A member who has withdrawn in full his/her capital contribution or membership in AMWSLAI and reacquired his/her membership when he/she was no longer assigned to the 410th MW and 420th SW at the time of his/her re-application for membership;
- 7.3.2 A member whose membership in AMWSLAI was terminated by the Association;
- 7.3.3 A member who at the time of the election has loan payment arrears for six (6) months or more;
- 7.3.4 A member convicted with finality, of any crime punishable by imprisonment of six (6) years and one day or more;
- 7.3.5 A member who commits election offenses and other prohibited acts, as defined by the AMWSLAI-COMELEC; and
- 7.3.6 Violation of the Association's rules and regulations.

Any member disqualified to vote under Subsection 6.2.3 above may be requalified by the AMWSLAI-COMELEC to vote if he/she has shown that such disqualification has ceased to exist at the time of the elections. The resolution of the AMWSLAI-COMELEC on the requalification of voters herein is final.
